LOCAL RULES

(as of 1st January 2019)

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

The areas beyond any perimeter fence or those areas indicated by White Stakes with Black Tops. Staked areas occur on holes 6, 7, 9 and 18. On holes 6, 7 and 18, the OOB is defined by the painted line on the outside edge of the concrete path. The line itself is OOB.

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

Red Penalty Areas Yellow Penalty Areas Red Stakes Yellow Stakes

Red Penalty Area with Blue Stakes Drop Zone Option:

If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the water hazard, the player may:

- (i) proceed under Rule 17; or
- (ii) as an additional option, drop the ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone. (When the player is using a dropping zone, the ball must be dropped in the dropping zone and it must come to rest in the dropping zone.)

3. Staked Trees (Rule 16.1)

Staked trees and staked shrubs are no play zones and are ground under repair (the GUR includes the stake)

4. Ground Under Repair (Rule 16.1)

Areas defined by a white line or GUR signage.

5. Garden Beds

Garden beds are integral objects from which no free relief is available.

6. Immovable Obstructions (eg Sprinkler Heads) Close to Putting Greens

- Line of Play Interference

Rule 16.1b applies to immovable obstructions close to putting greens. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if the immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play and is within two club-lengths of the putting green and is within two clublengths of the ball. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

7. Abnormal Conditions.

Should a ball come to rest in a bunker whilst ground staff are working within the bunker, the ball is deemed to lie in GUR 'through the green' and the player (without penalty) must drop the ball outside the bunker.

8. Seams of Cut Turf

If a player's ball in the general area lies in or touches a seam of cut turf, or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. But interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance. All seams within the area of cut turf are treated as the same seam in taking relief.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule;

Stroke Play- 2 strokes
Match Play- loss of hole.
